Maricopa County Community Colleges Rotational Watercolor Scholarship

- The Arizona Watercolor Association Scholarship has been established to honor artistic achievement in the medium of watercolor in students planning to attend or attending a Maricopa Community College (offered on a rotational basis).
2010: Glendale Community College and Paradise Valley Community College
- The \$500.00 AWA Scholarship recognizes art achievement and artistic involvement at the high school to community college level.

The Arizona Watercolor Association Scholarship recognizes each year the dedication of two students enrolled in watercolor during the year to further enhance and develop as a Fine Artist in Watercolor.

Eligibility: The recipient will be an active art student.

The art student will be required to take a watercolor class and to use the \$500.00 scholarship funds within 1 year.

Student must present proof of enrollment at the either of the two current eligible Maricopa Community Colleges, then the scholarship will be released to the college from AWA for disbursement to the chosen student.

The school must offer watercolor class and degrees in Fine Arts.

Submit:

1. The completed scholarship application form (MCC website and watercolor.org)
2. Your standard resume
3. Three (3) of your favorite watercolor art pieces – in pictures, digital or interview
4. Letter explaining coursework planning to enter
